Alistair Patrick-Heselton was 23 years-old when he was involved in a car crash, leaving him in a coma. Doctors thought Heselton would suffer severe brain damage and would probably never play football again. However, he left hospital just a few weeks after the crash, and is now on the path to representing his country at the **Paralympics with the GB Cerebral Palsy Football Team.**

On Monday, Alistair ran physically gruelling circuits which our children tried really hard to complete. His main motto in life is to 'Never give up and never let anything get in your way.' Our children felt that this reflected our school motto of, 'Aspire to Achieve' really well!

Southall Christmas Tree Lights Switch On!

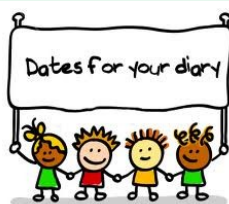
